Notes to Applicant



for Registration as Technician in Construction

Under the CIDB Act, a "Technician in Construction" is a "service provider" who provides construction services other than consultancy services.

A "Technician in construction" means a person who:

- (i) holds at least a diploma in a construction related field from a recognised institution;
- (ii) has five (5) years' post-academic qualification experience in the construction industry; and
- (iii) practices solely as freelance.

Note: Registration as "Technician in Construction" is not applicable to the following individuals:

- 1) persons already registered as contractor or consultant with the CIA
- 2) Professionals registered with their respective councils, including Engineers, Architects and Quantity Surveyors
- 3) Health and Safety Officers
- 4) Scaffold Supervisors
